Dear Primary Parents,

This year our Primary Parent-Teacher Conferences will take place on Friday, September 24th, and will continue throughout the following week if you are not available on that day. The conferences will be held online, and you will be emailed a 'sign-up' sheet for your child's conference. While our aim is to complete the majority of the conferences on the 24th we understand that not all parents will be available on this date. Please contact your child's teacher to arrange an alternate conference time if necessary.

Parent teacher conferences are an opportunity to speak with your child's teacher and find out how your child has settled into the new academic year. The aim of the conference is to discuss your child's progress and share areas of strength or concern. The focus of the conference is on your child's learning and developing partnerships to support and strengthen learning and teaching.

Friday 24th is also a planned House Day for all students in the PYP, this provides an opportunity for homeroom teachers to be available to facilitate your conferences. Our Athletics and Activities Department in collaboration with our specialist teachers and educational assistants have planned for a fun filled day for all students with a combination of on and offline activities. This day is planned to provide as much independence for our learners with limited adult support so parents can attend their child's conference. Our youngest learners from EY1 to Grade 1 will be participating in online learning in the morning and will be given offline activities for the afternoon. Grade 2 through Grade 5 students will participate in offline activities in the morning and will be participating in online activities in the afternoon.
