Invitation to join Developmental G3-Under Basketball Team

After the continued success of our G3-U Developmental Basketball Coaching over the last two year, we will be looking to do sign-up and trials for this year. We will be looking to run trials to be a part of a Boys and a Girls teams with both teams looking to take anywhere between 10-12 students. While it was great to see so many students playing basketball, we believe the students will be able to take more from the lesson if the size of the class is smaller. We will be looking to organize friendlies as well as the possibility of a Tournament at the end of the academic year. We hope this will further their development and their understanding of the rules of Basketball.

The development basketball will look at introducing and helping students to develop basic techniques such as dribbling, lay-ups and shooting as well as help teach students the basic rules of basketball. Students who are interested in getting involved in Basketball and are keen to join the team when they reach G4 should look to join as we hope this class will help better prepare our students.

Parents will be notified of the result of the trial via SMS on Friday 7th, evening time and you will be given a link to access the Sport's blog to view the result.

The first lesson will be Friday 6th September and will run until 22nd May 2020. Your child must commit to the team and look to attend every session once signed up.
