Dear Parents,

Please can I remind you that mobile phones are not allowed in the primary school, this includes both the hand held, and the wrist watch versions.

We are seeing a growing number of students wearing the e-watch version at school. There is no reason for this to be the case, students are always in the vicinity of a clock and can phone from the office if they need to talk to you; we have school devices for taking photos and videos at school for academic purposes and your children are safe on the school premises.

The watches are also very large and get in the way when playing or participating in PE classes, slip off the wrist and get lost or broken.

Please encourage your child to leave their watch at home. We will be talking to all the students and asking them to not wear them for school, on Thursday, should we see any we will be keeping them in the office for pick up at the end of the day.

I have two watches in my office already that have been found on the playground, both are exactly the same, both have flat batteries, if your child has lost a watch, please send in the charger so we can charge and identify the owners before returning.

Please support us in ensuring these devices are not worn at school, the possibilities of negative use far out way the positive reasons for wearing them.
