

Go Fish

Number bonds to 10.

Take a normal deck of playing cards and remove the picture cards and the 10s.

Deal 7 cards to each player. Place all other cards face down in the centre of the players.

Look at your cards and lay pairs that add to 10 face down in front of you. (eg 7 and 3)

The first player asks the player directly to their left for a card by saying “Do you have a ___?”, hoping that they will get a card that helps them make a pair that add to 10. If the player being asked has that card, they need to hand it to the player who asked for the card. If the player does not have the card, they say “Go fish”. Then the player who asked for the card takes one card from the top of the pile of cards in the centre.

Play continues in a clockwise direction until one player has no cards left in their hand because they have made pairs with all their cards. The game then stops and all players count their pairs.

The winner is the player with the most pairs.
