

# What We Will Be Learning For The Week of Sep 27 - Oct 1

Math	In math lessons this week our students will look at visual estimation, and practice their skip counting skills to find the exact number of a collection of things. Students will also begin inquiring into mental math strategies for addition, and continue to develop their number skills while through our math prodigy and IXL online applications.
Language	In language lessons this week our students will be inquiring into non-fiction texts. They will learn about some of the key features of non-fiction and practice using these features to find useful information. Later in the week students will also read material related to our unit of inquiry and begin gather information that will inform activities throughout the unit.
UOI	This week our students will begin learning about the different aspects of well-being, and reflect on the things that they do to help maintain a healthy lifestyle. Students will spend time thinking about what it means to be balanced and reflect on the choices that people make, and how that can affect their health.
Reading	This week students will continue to read independently and be encouraged to try different activities from our new reading choice board. They will also continue to develop their reading comprehension skills during guided reading lessons and spend time reading non-fiction texts related to health and well-being.
