

## Grade 2 Learning and Resources For The Week of Sep 13 - 15

<b>Math</b>	During math lessons this week students will learn and practice the math concept of rounding numbers to the nearest 10 and 100. Students will also show the different ways to represent and think about a number and spend time practicing their number skills while playing Math Prodigy.
<b>Language</b>	During language lessons students will continue to review their phonics knowledge, while building their vocabulary and practicing their sentence writing skills. Students will also continue to listen our class novel, 'George's Marvellous Medicine' and complete fun comprehension activities based on the novel.
<b>Unit of Inquiry</b>	During unit of inquiry lessons the students will be asked to apply their learning from this unit of inquiry during a final activity. This learning experience will ask them to think about a way that they can create or improve a system to help a community function more effectively. They will do this using skills that they have built throughout this unit, such as mind mapping, flow charts, and sequential writing.
<b>Reading</b>	In their guided reading groups our students will continue to read together with their teacher and classmates. During independent reading lessons students are encouraged to continue to read everyday and use the choice grid to help them share what their reading and thinking.

<b>Music:</b>	Learning Outcome: Students will understand that the great musicians use symbols to represent sounds and innovate systems to communicate ideas. Resources Needed: Device. Internet connection. Paper, pencils, coloured pencils.
<b>Art:</b>	Learning Outcome: Students will continue to demonstrate their knowledge of the elements and principles of art through drawing. Resources Needed: sketchbook, drawing materials (colored pencil, crayon, marker, etc)
<b>PE:</b>	Learning Outcome: The students will recognize basic movement levels and pathways. Resources Needed: 1 large ball, 1 small ball.
<b>Thai</b>	Learning Outcome: -Using Think Puzzle Explore , thinking routine for Thai traditional games -Reading grade-level text with purpose and understanding. (เรื่อง กากับเหยือกน้ำ) Resources Needed: Line Paper, Pencil, Eraser, Marker
<b>TAL:</b>	Thai Learning Outcome: Reviewing vocabulary of numbers, colours, body parts and Thai letters. Students are able to recognise and identify the learned vocabulary. Students learn to make simple sentences in Thai. Resources Needed: white board, marker, coloured pencils, Thai package.
