

What We Will Be Learning For The Week of Dec 7 - Dec 10

<p>Math</p>	<p>In math lessons this week our students will be inquiring further into the connections between addition and subtraction. Students will learn how addition can help their understanding of subtraction, and vice versa. Later in the week students will apply their computation and thinking skills while working to solve word based problems.</p>
<p>Language</p>	<p>In language lessons our students will continue to follow the writing process. The students will work with a partner to proofread their drafted work to help them identify and fix spelling and punctuation mistakes. Afterwards they will begin to publish their story and get it ready to share with others.</p>
<p>Unit of Inquiry</p>	<p>During our unit of inquiry activities our students will be working on creating their own example of visual and performance art. The students are encouraged to express themselves creatively and try their best to create different artwork examples they are proud of.</p>
<p>Reading</p>	<p>In reading lessons this week students will practice reading the written work of fellow students, and searching for punctuation and spelling mistakes. Students will also work on strategies for reading word based problems during math lessons and continue to focus on reading fiction stories and responding in our fiction reading choice board.</p>

<p>Music: Learning Outcome: Students will be able to use music technology to manipulate three of the musical elements to create music. Resources Needed: Devise, internet connection, log on to chrome music labs: https://musiclab.chromeexperiments.com/</p> <p>Art: Learning Outcome: Students will inquire into the elements of art, specifically texture, and principle of design, pattern, through weaving. Resources Needed: *Group 1 and Group 2 have been provided with palm fronds* Group 3 can substitute cardstock or thick paper, scissors, pencil, ruler</p> <p>PE: Learning Outcome: The students will be reflecting on Term 1 skills, including manipulative, locomotor and non locomotor skills, along with spatial awareness movements. Resources Needed: 1 small ball, 1 large ball, 1 container, 1 bat</p> <p>Thai Learning Outcome: -Students will learn Thai grammar: สระเนื่อ -Students will explore different types of Thai instrumental music. (OUI:Thai arts part 4 Cont.) -Students will read grade-level text with purpose and understanding. Resources Needed: Line Paper, Pencil, Eraser, Marker</p> <p>TAL: Thai Learning Outcome: Reviewing all the learned vocabulary, sentences and conversation.
