

Grade 2 Learning and Resources For The Week of Sep 6 - 10

Math	On Wednesday this week students will complete their start of the year math assessment on IXL.com. In other Math lessons students will learn more challenging ways to think about numbers and the connections between different place values, as well as how to write numbers in word form and use cardinal numbers such as 1st, 2nd, and 3rd effectively.
Language	In language lessons this week our students will spend time on Raz-Kids either completing another Flight Check assessment, or reading material targeted at their appropriate reading level. Our students will also spend time developing their phonics awareness and vocabulary, and continue to practice the use of sequence words in their writing.
Unit of Inquiry	During unit of inquiry lessons this week our students will work to connect the big ideas we have focused on with regards to 'systems' and 'communities'. Students will be asked to think about how the systems inside a community functions, and different roles and responsibilities that people can have within a community.
Reading	In their guided reading groups our students will continue to read together with their teacher and classmates using the books from our take home packs. During independent reading lessons students are encouraged to continue to read everyday and use the choice grid to help them share what their reading and thinking.

Music:

Learning Outcome: Students will understand that the great composers innovate and use symbols to represent sounds.

Resources Needed: Device. Internet connection. Paper, pencils, coloured pencils.

Art:

Learning Outcome: The students will explore and incorporate the elements of art and principles of design into their artwork.

Resources Needed: sketchbook, pencils, coloring materials

PE:

Learning Outcome: The students will explore and recognize a variety of locomotor and non locomotor manipulative skills.

Resources Needed: 1 small ball. 1 large ball. 1 water bottle. 1 small container. 1 hard covered book

Learning Outcome:

- Understanding Thai vowels: สระอะ มีตัวสะกด/ ไม่มีตัวสะกด
- Using diagrams mapping growth mindset and fixed mindset.
- Reading grade-level text with purpose and understanding.

TAL:

Learning Outcome: Reviewing number 0-1000, and colours in Thai. Reviewing Thai letters and vowels ำ. Students will learn vocabulary of the Body parts and to make simple sentences using "have" "don't have"
