

What We Will Be Learning For The Week of Nov 1-5

Math	In math lessons this week students will continue to learn and practice their mental addition and subtraction skills. The focus for this week will be on adding and subtracting using a number line. Students will also continue to practice their skills while completing IXL activities and playing online and offline math games.
Language	In language lessons this week students will be reading and thinking about the concept of cause and effect. They will read about how it applies in all areas of our lives. Students will also spend time building their vocabulary, phonetic awareness and sentence writings skills.
Unit of Inquiry	This will be the final week of this unit of inquiry and students will be working to make connections between the different aspects of health and well-being that we've been learning about this unit. Student will put together their knowledge while creating their own 'wellness plan' and mindmap
Reading	This will be the final week for our non-fiction focused choice board. Students will be asked to apply what they've learned about main idea supporting details, and finding cause and effect relationships.
