

What We Will Be Learning For The Week of Nov 22-26

Math	In math lessons this week our students will review their column addition skills, with a focus on regrouping and solving problems with larger numbers. Later in the week students will be completing two different math assessments designed to check their progress and understanding. At the end of the week students will inquire into different concepts involving 2D shapes.
Language	In language lessons this week, students will work to plan a story that they would like to write. Students will use their creativity to plan the characters, setting, and important elements of their story. Our students will also be learning how to use quotation marks in order to add dialogue into their story writing.
Unit of Inquiry	Our unit of inquiry focus next week will be on how artists use different visual and performing arts to tell stories. Students will inquire into the art of mime, sand art, picture books and clay sculpture, and experiment with how we can use these mediums to tell a story and express ourselves.
Reading	In reading lessons this week, students will complete their November reading assessment. They will also continue to focus on reading fiction stories and responding in our fiction reading choice board.

<p><u>Music:</u> Learning Outcome: Students will understand that symbols can be used to represent sounds and that there is an internationally recognised system for doing this. Students will create and communicate rhythms using standard notation. Resources Needed: Devise, internet connection, white board, marker, pencils and paper</p> <p><u>Art:</u> Learning Outcome: Students will inquire into the elements of art, specifically texture, and principle of design, pattern, through weaving. Resources Needed: thin cardboard or thick paper, yarn (2 meters), tape, scissors, pencil, something circular to trace *Provided to Groups 1 and 2*</p> <p><u>PE:</u> Learning Outcome: The students will identify basic skills and non locomotor motions which will enhance their performance in games and P.E. activities. Resources Needed: 1 small ball, 1 large ball, 1 racket or hard covered book, 1 balloon.</p> <p><u>Thai</u> Learning Outcome: -Students will learn Thai grammar: ตัวการ์ตูนต์ -Students will draw simple Thai patterns.(OUI:Thai arts part 3 Cont.) -Students will read grade-level text with purpose and understanding. Resources Needed:Line Paper, Pencil, Eraser, Marker</p> <p><u>TAL:</u> Thai Learning Outcome: students learn to tell time in Thai. Resources Needed: Mini whiteboard, Markers, coloured pencils, Thai orange book.</p>
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
