

What We Will Be Learning For The Week of Nov 29 - Dec 03

Math	In math lessons this week we will spend time reviewing some of the learning connected to 2D shapes, before inquiring into different methods of subtraction. Students will learn about mental subtraction methods that can help subtract numbers in their head. Afterwards students will practice subtracting larger numbers using the column subtraction technique.
Language	In language lessons this week students will learn about verb tenses, specifically past tense verbs that they will use while writing their narrative piece. Afterwards students will continue along the writing process while drafting and then revising their story.
Unit of Inquiry	During our unit of inquiry activities this week we will begin with by experimenting with clay and sculpture. The students will create sculptures inspired by characters and scenes from their story. Later in the week students will look and think about famous works of art from a variety of art forms. At the end of the week students will begin to plan a visual and performing art that they would like to use to express themselves.
Reading	In reading lessons this week students will practice reading their written work and search for ways that they can improve their, as well as reading the work of others and giving feedback. Students will also continue to focus on reading fiction stories and responding in our fiction reading choice board.
