

What We Will Be Learning For The Week of Oct 4-8

Math	In math lessons this week we will begin inquiring into how we collect and represent data. During live lessons together, and at home with their families, our students will spend time asking questions and collecting data, and then work to show this data in proper bar graph form. Our students will also continue practicing their number skills throughout the week.
Language	In language lessons this week we will spend time reading from non-fiction texts and gathering information related to our unit of inquiry. Our students will be reading and finding out about the different aspects of physical exercise and how exercise and sleep affect our well-being.
Unit of Inquiry	This week in unit of inquiry lessons our students will be inquiring into the 'zones of regulation'. The students will learn how to think about these zones and use them to think about their day to day emotional well being. The students will also be encouraged to connect these ideas to what they have learned about mindfulness practices in the past week.
Reading	This week we will be introducing a new Independent Reading Choice Board. The activities on this board will be related to non-fiction texts, and as such students will be asked to choose and read non-fiction material during independent reading time.
