

# Grade 2 Learning and Resources For The Week of August 30 - Sep 3

Math	During math lessons this week students will be asked to connect their number sense and their reading, writing and thinking skills. They will be asked to solve 'Mystery Number' riddles that test their place value knowledge, write and share their own riddle examples, and practice writing numbers in word form.
Language	This week much of our language lesson focus will be on completing our start of the year reading and writing assessments. Students will be asked to take their first 'Flight Check' on Raz-kids.com, and complete a writing sample using a simple narrative writing prompt.
Unit of Inquiry	During our unit of inquiry activities, students will take a closer look at the systems within communities that allow them to function effectively. Students will think about the different ways that people and things need to work together in order to be successful.
Reading	This week students will be introduced to a new 'Reading Choice Board' with new, fun ideas for how they can share their understanding of the independent reading that they do.
