

# What We Will Be Learning For The Week of Nov 15-19

Math	At the start of the unit students will focus on the algorithm or column method for adding larger numbers. Later in the week students will continue their inquiry into shape and space while learning about regular and irregular polygons, and angles.
Language	This week in language lessons our students will be learning more about the different elements of narrative writing. Students will focus on describing the setting and retelling the important plot points within a read aloud story.
Unit of Inquiry	Our unit of inquiry focus this week will be considering some big questions from the unit, such as what is and what isn't art? The students will also think about all the different forms of artistic expression and then work to sort them into categories of visual art and performing art.
Reading	Students will spend time reading dramatic plays. The students will practice using verbal expression, and reading with the appropriate volume and pace. Students are also encouraged to complete activities from the fiction reading choice board while at home.

<p><b>Music:</b> Learning Outcome: Students will understand that symbols can be used to represent sounds and that there is an internationally recognised system for doing this. Students will create and communicate rhythms using standard notation. Resources Needed: Devise, internet connection, white board, marker, pencils and paper</p>
<p><b>Art:</b> Learning Outcome: Students will inquire into the elements of art, specifically texture, and principle of design, pattern, through weaving. Resources Needed: Sketchbook, colored or recycled paper (we will cut into strips), scissors, glue or tape.</p>
<p><b>PE:</b> Learning Outcome: The students will identify locomotor and non locomotor movements connections required for games and activities. Resources Needed: 1 small ball, 1 large ball, 1 bat or hard covered book, 1 balloon.</p>
<p><b>Thai</b> Learning Outcome: -Students will learn Thai grammar: สระอ้อมมีตัวสะกด/ไม่มีตัวสะกด -Students will draw simple Thai patterns.(OUI:Thai arts part 3) -Students will read grade-level text with purpose and understanding. Resources Needed:Line Paper, Pencil, Eraser, Marker</p> <p><b>TAL:</b> Thai Learning Outcome: Students review action words such as speak, listen, write, read, drink, eat, walk, run, sit down, stand up, jump. Resources Needed: mini whiteboard, marker, coloured pencils.</p>
