

What We Will Be Learning For The Week of Nov 8-12

Math	During this week's math lessons students will be inquiring into shapes and space for the first time this school year. Students will spend time working, thinking and classifying 2D shapes. This week students will also spend time working on their column addition skills.
Language	In Language lessons this week our students will be developing their narrative writing skills. They will practice ways to use their writing ability to tell stories from visual prompts and their imagination. Students will also spend time reading different dramatic pieces of writing.
Unit of Inquiry	This week the students will begin a new unit of inquiry. The theme of the unit is 'How We Express Ourselves', and the students will explore what it means to be creative and how we can express ourselves through different forms of artwork and language. This week students will be encouraged to tap into their creativity and think about art and where we see it in the world.
Reading	This week students will be tuning in to a new Reading Choice Grid. This new grid will represent our change in focus from non-fiction, to more creative texts such as stories, poems and plays.

Students review Thai letters ก-ง. Resources Needed: Markers, coloured pencils, Thai package</p>
