As our online learning programme goes live this morning, we would like to take this opportunity to share some points that may be useful to ensure our students are able to make the most of the online learning programme.

1. Make a plan for the day that will work for you and your family.

- Block off times for school work, leisure/snack breaks, exercise etc.
- Balance is important with screen time and some tasks can be completed on paper or in a workbook. Students can then take a photo of their work and upload it onto seesaw or share it with us directly.

2. Maximise “school/work” times

- Dedicate a place in your house that is most free of distractions that your child can complete their learning in.

3. Be proactive!

- We welcome your feedback and are here to help. Please email us with any questions you may have, or any support you need.

4. Stay connected

- We want to ensure everyone is feeling engaged and connected with one another in this learning community. Reach out if we can help support you in any way to make home learning more successful.

Each day we will be sharing our learning outcomes using Google classroom as our main platform. A morning post will be published at 9am to check in for the day, we ask all students to watch the video carefully and post a simple comment underneath to show they have seen the video. All learning tasks will be posted daily using a ‘must do, can do’ page, another tool our students are familiar with. At the end of each day, at around 2pm, we will be posting a second video to reflect on the learning from the day and provide class feedback so please remind students to check Google Classroom again.

In recent weeks, in the classroom, we have been exploring tools that may be used if we needed to go online and feel that our students have the skills needed to rise to this new challenge.

All teachers will be present throughout the day to support and challenge learning. We welcome any questions from our students and will be providing feedback for the learning tasks being completed.

As we face this new challenge, we appreciate your continued support and will be frequently reflecting to ensure we are best meeting the needs of our students. Please do not hesitate to contact us with any questions or feedback that you have along the way.
