Music	Learning Outcome: Students will begin to understand that we can use patterns of chords to create songs, how those chords are constructed and how we select which notes are most suitable for use with each chord. Art	Learning Outcome: Students will inquire into the elements of art (texture, shape, color, form) Resources Needed: Sketchbook, collected papers (colored paper, magazine, gift wrap, etc), scissors, glue, coloring materials, recycled objects such as bottle caps, straws, plastic cutlery
P.E.	Learning Outcome: Students will be able to sprint with high knees and arms swinging from pocket to socket. Resources Needed: Something to make a line with
THAI	Learning Outcome: Students will read Thai literature สังข์ทอง (Sang Thong) # 3-4 and paraphrase the poem. UOI: Migration: Students will focus their thinking about topics of debate "Migration from Ayutthaya Kingdom to Thonburi Kingdom and show their position on Four-corner debate activity. Resources Needed : papers , pencils, eraser, coloured pencils, markers, whiteboard
TAL	Students can identify parts of the body in Thai through listening, speaking and writing, and give the meaning of different sentences or texts related to the topic. Resources Needed: computer/ipad, google sheets, blank papers, pencil, scissors, color markers, whiteboard etc.
